Mobilizing Support Transnationally: Taiwanese voters in Vienna and the 2020 Presidential Elections in Taipei

As social relations extend across the borders of nation states in a globalising world, electorates are increasingly geographically dispersed and political mobilisation transnationalized. Notwithstanding, many migrants still face procedural and institutional obstacles for participating in homeland elections, including the approximately two million Taiwanese citizens scattered across the globe. Taiwan conditions the right to vote by permanent residency in the national territory requiring those who wish to vote to return home. This lecture delves into the phenomenon of transnational electoral participation in the context of the institutional absence of an external voting system. With a case study on the Taiwanese community in Vienna (Austria), it explains how the specific socio-political characteristics of the local Taiwanese emigrant community informed transnational voter mobilisation, and what effect it had on electoral participation in the 2020 presidential elections.

Julia Marinaccio is a comparative political scientist holding a Ph.D. in China Studies from the University Vienna and an M.A. in Political Science from National Chengchi University (NCCU), Taipei. Currently, she works as a postdoctoral researcher at the Department of Foreign Languages/Chinese Studies at the University of Bergen. Her primary research interests lie in regime politics and authoritarian governance in China and political transnationalism in Taiwan.
